In memory of Alwin Lehner, the ALPLA Group offers a scholarship for particularly talented and committed students. Applicants must be eligible and studying at an institution supported by ALPLA (university, university of applied sciences) in a field of study relevant to ALPLA.

What do I receive as a scholarship holder and what do I have to do to get it?

As a scholarship holder, you will receive 3.600 Euros per semester for two academic years, paid out at the beginning of each semester. The prerequisite is a positive performance record of at least 20 ECTS points per semester and the status of a full-time student.



We would like to draw your attention to the possibility of completing internships at ALPLA during the scholarship. Internships at one of the many ALPLA locations abroad are particularly attractive.

Scholarship holders are assigned a mentor for the duration of the scholarship. The mentor is the main contact person for the scholarship holders and supports them during their introduction to the company and throughout the entire duration of the scholarship program.

How to apply?

The following documents are required:

- Resume (CV)
- Letter of motivation: "What is my motivation to apply for an Alwin Lehner Scholarship?" (max. 2 pages)
- Explanation of why a scholarship is needed from a financial point of view
- Enrolment or confirmation of a study place for the upcoming semester (if already available) in one of the requested subjects
- University certificate, high school diploma, internship certificates (if already available)
- Copy of the passport

How are the scholarship holders selected?

Following a pre-selection process, selected applicants will be invited to meet in person at the company headquarters in Hard, Vorarlberg, Austria on **July 4, 2025**.

The scholarship holders will be selected by July 25, 2025 - at the latest.

A committee will decide on the awarding of the scholarships at its own discretion. Legal recourse is excluded.
